KATA REGULATIONS

EACH COMPETITOR WILL PARTICIPATE WITH HIS GRADE BELT.

Special consideration will be given to the qualification of the kata, the correct execution of the technique according to the style, the embusen, the complexity of the kata, speed and power, muscle connection and correct breathing according to the karate style.

If there are less than 8 competitors in a category, only one round will be executed and the kata of the second round may be executed according to the details of their category.

If there are 9 or more competitors

Round 1: the 4 competitors with the highest score move on to the 2nd round.

Round 2: the 3 best competitors will receive medals.

IN CASE OF A TIE

Round 3: the 3 best competitors will receive medals in all categories and the decision will be based on points, in case of a tie, the lower score will be added up, if a tie persists, the highest score will be added up, if a tie persists, they must perform a new kata and may or may not repeat the kata based on the specifications of their category.

The grounds for disqualification are: the fall of the belt, not saluting at the beginning and end of kata add or delete a technique to the kata, ignore the rules of each category regarding the repetition of the kata as detailed in the following rules the rules. To the list of Tokui Katas are added: Hyakuhachiho, Sansai, Senka.

KUMITE RULES

KUMITE RULES The WUKF rules will be used as a basis.

- In case of a tie there will be an extension with a golden point, if it persists, the judges will determine the winner by Hantei.
- Every technique must end in Sanchin to be considered scoring.

Penalties:

ATENAI: Techniques that make excessive contact, taking into account the scoring area attacked. scoring area attacked.

- a) First Warning: Atenai
- b) Final Warning: Ateani Chui
- c) Disqualification: Atenai Hansoku

KINSHI comprises the following behaviors

- a) Waste of time.
 - b) Exaggerated actions feigning injury.
 - c) Any behavior that may bring Karate into disrepute.
 - d) Any disrespectful and unnecessary actions
 - e) Any situation in which the competitor shows a lack of regard for his own safety.
 - f) Any situation in which the competitor touches the ground outside the competition area with any part of his or her body, as follows of his body, as follows
 - g) Grab (unless immediately followed by a technique).
- Possible warnings or penalties are scalable:
 - a) First Warning: Kinshi
 - b) Second Kinshi Warning
 - c) Final Warning: Kinshi Chui
 - d) Disqualification: Kinshi Hansoku
 - All claims must be made through the delegate of the Club, Dojo or Organization.
 - The medical staff of the event is the only one authorized in case of injury or excessive contact to give the authorization to resume or cancel the bout. to resume or cancel the bout.
 - The competitor may not make any angry gesture of complaint, nor raise his voice to the referee. Any discourteous will be cause for disqualification and will be reported to the court of honor of the PKDA.

IMPORTANT

1. The sportsman is obliged to present his/her identity documents when requested to do so.
2. The sportsman will be weighed before the tournament to prove his category, if falsehood is proven, he will be fined S/.30.00 Soles or \$10.00 US Dollars and will compete in his respective category. fined with S/.30.00 Soles or \$10.00 U.S. Dollars and will compete in their respective category.
3. If necessary, categories will be put together after consultation with the delegate
4. All Coaches and Delegates must be properly accredited and identified.
5. Only duly accredited Coaches or Delgados (one per Dojo per tatami) will be allowed to enter the competition area. (one per Dojo per tatami).
6. Medical assistance shall only be provided in the area of competence.
